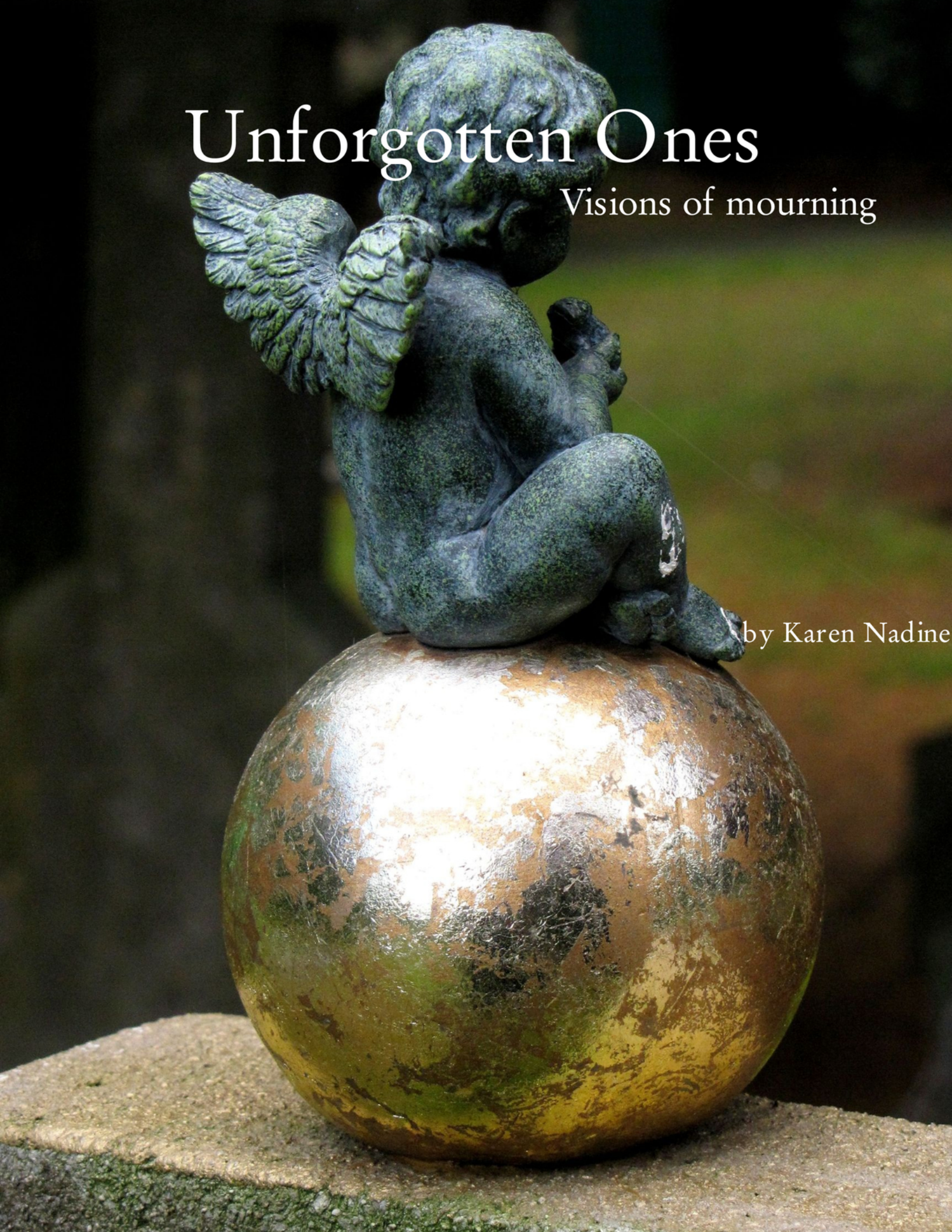


Unforgotten Ones
